

**AB 516 DISCLOSURE  
(Gov. Code, § 66006(e))**

These public facilities fees are imposed under the City of Grass Valley Public Facilities Fee Ordinance and the Mitigation Fee Act.

**NOTICE**

As the Payor of the fees, you have a right to:

- I. Submit a request to the Department of Finance for an audit under Government Code Section 66023 to determine:
  - a. Whether any fee exceeds the amount reasonably necessary to cover the cost of any product, public facility, or service provided by the City;
  - b. When the revenue generated by a fee is scheduled to be expended; and
  - c. When the public improvement is scheduled to be completed.
- II. File a written request to the City Clerk to receive mailed notice of the City of Grass Valley Council's meeting to review the information regarding each fee's account or fund ("Annual Report").

**PROTEST PROCEDURES**

The Payor may protest the imposition of any fees, dedications, reservations, or other exactions imposed on a development project. A protest filed pursuant to Government Code section 66020 shall be filed at the time of approval or conditional approval of the development or within 90 days after the date of the imposition of the fees, dedications, reservations, or other exactions to be imposed on a development project. If a protest is filed, the Payor may file an action to attack, review, set aside, void, or annul the imposition of the fees, dedications, reservations, or other exactions imposed on a development project by a local agency within 180 days after the delivery of the notice.
